

Behaviour Consultant – Lower Mainland

posAbilities is a large non-profit agency that delivers services to people with developmental disabilities. We also provide behavioural consulting to children and adults with an Autism Spectrum Disorder, and their families.

Laurel Behaviour Support Services (LBSS) is a program of *posAbilities*, and we are looking for a qualified Behaviour Consultant to work with families who have children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and/or other developmental disorders living in the Vancouver Lower Mainland. LBSS is a home-based consultation program that develops individualized programs based on the science of Applied Behaviour Analysis.

The successful candidate will conduct assessments, collect data, write and revise behavioural support plans, work with family members on setting and achieving specific goals for their child, provide clinical supervision to behaviour interventionists on the team, model/teach implementation strategies, and provide the team with basic training (as needed). LBSS will provide the successful candidate with clinical support and oversight.

Successful candidates must have:

- A graduate degree in applied behaviour analysis, education, psychology or a related discipline.
- BCBA certification with the BACB
- A minimum 2 years experience providing support to children, youth and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder and/or other developmental disability.
- An thorough understanding of the principles of applied behaviour analysis and can communicate them effectively.
- The ability to conduct and interpret indirect, direct and experimental functional assessments and develop function-based interventions.
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills and the ability to work independently.
- Eligibility to be on the “Category A” of the Qualified service Provider list maintained by Autism Community Training (<http://www.actcommunity.net>).

Preference may be given to candidates with fluency in another language
