Under the direction of the Clinical Supervisor and the Behaviour Consultant, The Behaviour Interventionist is responsible for implementing behaviour intervention plans and programs developed by a Behaviour Consultant in the private home environment of children and adults with behavioural and emotional challenges in addition to physical and/or cognitive needs. The Behaviour Interventionist will provide ABA behaviour management and skills training to persons served. As there are trusting relationships to be formed in this position an 8-10 month commitment (1 year preferred) is requested from all applicants at \$19.11/hour. We offer BC ABA supervision of all work and supplemental Life Skills contracts at \$17.88/hour.
