A Shared Living contractor's role is to:

- Provide a safe, warm, inclusive and healthy environment.
- Be a positive role model, offer supports that are respectful and sensitive, and provide structure and stability.
- Have experience and/or training in supporting persons with developmental disabilities, FASD, Autism, mental health issues, personal care, and medical support needs.

To participate in **posAbilities'** Shared Living Services, several pieces of documentation and certifications are required which will be discussed upon application. Approval does not in any way guarantee that you will be selected to provide Shared Living services with **posAbilities**, there are many factors that are considered when making a match. This is a contracted position.

We are looking for the following:

Vancouver: A man in his 50's is seeking a **live in** caregiver he can get to know and trust as his parent's age.

Vancouver: A man in his 50's is seeking a home where he can have a bedroom and share in all aspects of daily living.

New Westminster/Burnaby/Tri-Cities: Ideally a suite for a lady in her 30's who is very active in Special Olympics, has close network of friends and family, day supports. A bedroom, bathroom and den would also be suitable, as she desires to spend time with her home share provider.

Vancouver/Burnaby: A suite for a lady who takes pride in her independence, loves to cook and is busy with Special Olympics and working.
